

Christmas Sleigh Ride

Designed with Christmas Toile by Moda in mind, this quilt would also be great in batiks or other prints. You will trim the blocks as you go to make sure they fit together perfectly. The 4" center square is also large enough to be used for inserting a picture, small batik panel, or pre-embroidered block. Simple cornerstone sashing and a coordinating mitered border will pull them together nicely. I've also included a simple piecing diagram for the blocks with templates, just in case you would like to create them in the traditional way.

Supplies for 56" x 70" lap quilt:

Fabric:

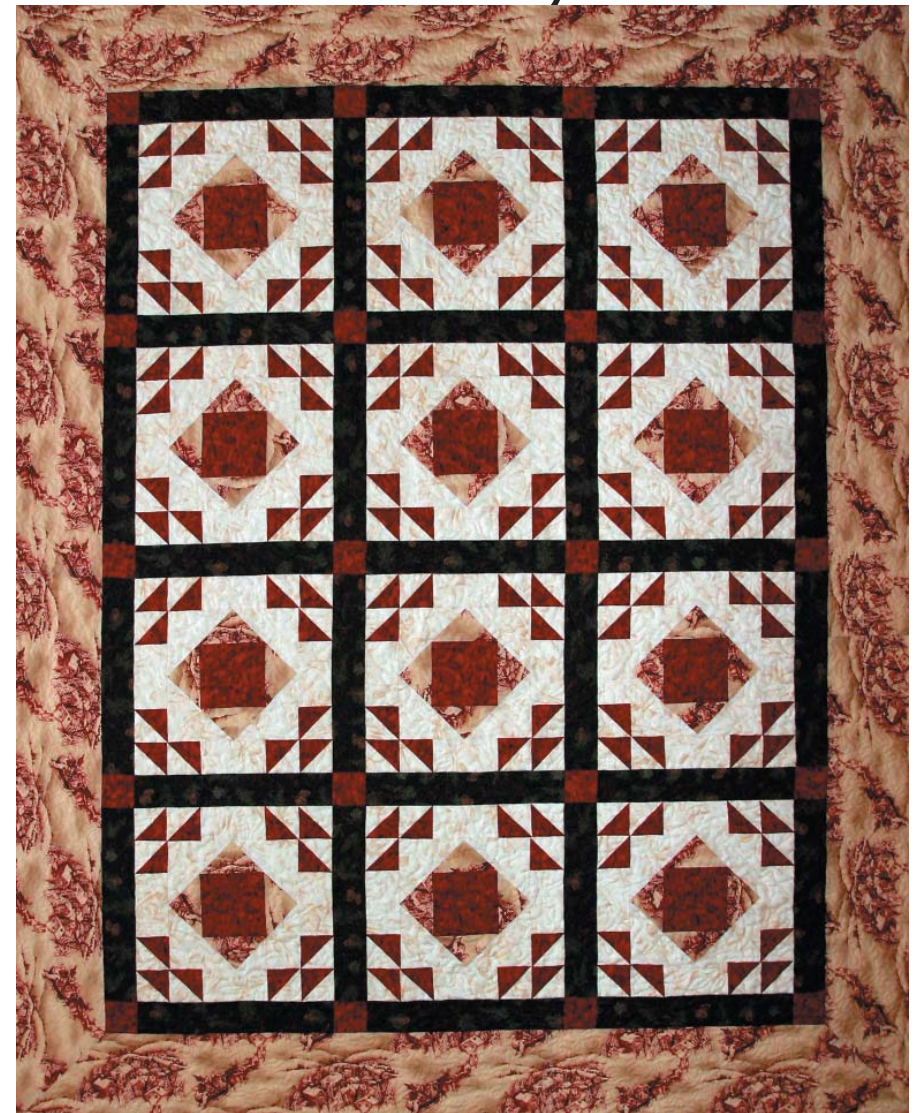
- 2 ½ yards of red / tan print for the blocks and border
- 1 ½ yards of red for the blocks, corner stones, and binding
- 1 ¼ yards of cream for the block background
- 1 ¼ yards of green for the sashing
- 3 ½ yards of backing fabric
- 62" x 76" or larger batting

General sewing supplies:

- Rotary cutter, 6 x 24" rotary ruler and mat
- 9 or 12" rotary ruler (optional, but nice to have)
- Sewing thread to match fabrics
- Template plastic for templates (optional)
