

Wild Waves

Brighten up your world with Wild Waves! It is easier than you think with foundation piecing. If you're not into the bold prints, it would also look good in batiks or even pastels, by choosing 2 color families (here I used the warm and cool), and adding a contrasting color (I used black).

Fabric requirements:

Fabric A (1) - red: 1/4 yard

Fabric B (2) – deep yellow: 1/2 yard

Fabric C (3) – dark blue: 1/4 yard

Fabric D (4) - blue: 1/3 yard

Fabric E (5) – main print: 1-1/2 yards

Fabric F (6) - purple: 1/3 yard

Fabric G (7) - black: 5/8 yard

Fabric H (8) - green: 1/3 yard

Fabric J (9) - yellow: 1/2 yard

Backing and rod pocket fabric: 1-1/2 yard

Other supplies needed:

42" square of batting

General sewing and quilting supplies

General rotary cutting supplies

Index or postcard

"Add-a-quarter" ruler (recommended), or other small rotary ruler

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38" x 38"
foundation pieced
wall quilt
